For the past 20 years, David Lubarsky has been working in New York City as an independent assignment photographer creating inspired images of people & places for the editorial, corporate & fine art markets. His work has been published worldwide in consumer & trade magazines, corporate publications, web sites and annual reports. In addition, his work has been exhibited by MTA/ Arts for Transit, Louis K. Meisel Gallery, Nikon House Gallery, The Silvermine Guild and FAC Gallery among others and is included in the permanent collection of The Museum of the City of New York.

Joseph Paschke, Creative Director

A graduate of Pratt Institute, he holds a Bachelor's degree in Communication Design. He has won awards from the Society of Illustrators and Society of Publication Designers, and was awarded a group Pulitzer Prize for coverage of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks. He lives in Fairfield, Connecticut with his wife and two sons.

Joseph Paschke has worked for over 20 years at some of the top publishing houses in New York including Time Warner, American Express, Hearst, and Dow Jones. He has been an Art Director and Designer for Travel & Leisure, Worth, Smart Money, and Fortune and was the Creative Director of money.com magazine. As the Associate Design Director of the Wall Street Journal he managed a group of 40 graphic artists and Art Directors.

Ulla Surland, Designer

Ulla Surland studied fashion design at Marymount College (now a part of Fordham University) and was awarded a Bachelor of Arts and Science degree, Summa Cum Laude, in 1982. She subsequently worked for a number of design firms in NYC gaining experience as a fashion designer. She traveled to Hong Kong, Taiwan, South Korea, Bali, Greece and Tobago to supervise clothing production and to facilitate fashion photo shoots. She has worked as a fine art photographer and as a teacher of photography at Westchester Community College.

In 1998, Ms Surland opened a fine art gallery in Fairfield, CT specializing in contemporary art. She curated 8 shows per year providing a distinguished venue for emerging and mid career artists. Her gallery was well known for the high quality of art shown and was frequented by many art lovers and collectors. Ms Surland has served as guest curator and judge at Art Works in Hartford and at the Westport Art Center.
